THE ROLE

We are looking to recruit two Youth Workers to join our successful district team. The location of this role is in the district provision and the Mahdlo hub.

You will provide professional youth work to deliver a range of exciting programmes to children and young people that will challenge, stimulate and provide new opportunities, in line with Mahdlo's six themes.

The ideal candidate will have a qualification recognised by the JNC for Youth and Community Work.

You will have experience of face to face youth work delivery and will be confident in working with and managing children and young people (8-19 years old both in groups and individually) to develop their social education by providing programmes of activities, services and facilities that are engaging and enable young people to develop.

You will also have a commitment to personal and professional development.

You must be committed to working within the spirit of Mahdlo's core values - Pride, Respect, Inclusion, Dependability and Excellence - which describe the way we work.

JOB PURPOSE

To provide professional youth work to deliver a range of exciting programmes to children and young people that will challenge, stimulate and provide new opportunities, in line with the Mahdlo key themes; Get Sorted (personal development, crime prevention and health and wellbeing) and Get Connected (leadership, volunteering and citizenship);

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Working directly with children and young people (8-12 years and / or 13-19 years) to develop their social skills and build their confidence by delivering programmes of activities, services and facilities at Mahdlo which will take place during the evenings, at weekends and during school holidays and will occasionally include residential work.
- To directly deliver a planned, high quality programme of activity that is exciting, safe, and developmental and directly responds to the diverse needs, concerns and interests of our members. Offering opportunities and encouraging young people to participate in a range of activities and experiences across our 6 key themes: Get Active; Get Creative; Get Sorted; Get Outdoors; Get Connected; Get Ahead.
- Where required contribute to the development of plans for delivery of youth work sessions and projects
- To deliver and evidence projects to support with the delivery of preventative issue based youth work
- To establish positive relationships with young people, to challenge, support and encourage them to participate positively.
- To work with children and young people in groups, 1-2-1 and in outreach settings.
- To work flexibly to ensure the needs of our members are met, including disadvantaged children and young people and those with disabilities or additional needs.
- To ensure that our members maintain a high standard of behaviour and discipline during sessions.
- To work alongside and support Activity Workers, Volunteers and Young Leaders to deliver our programmes.

- To promote cultural cohesion and inclusion, and proactively challenge any prejudice and discrimination.
- Ensure the participation of young people and that their ideas contribute fully in the delivery and evaluation of sessions, projects and activities.
- To understand and adhere to Mahdlo policies and procedures at all times with particular emphasis on equal opportunities, health and safety and safeguarding.
- To have responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people at all times.
- To monitor, record and evaluate sessions in accordance with Mahdlo's systems.
- To be an active member of the team and deliver a focused, measurable contribution to Mahdlo operating in line with Mahdlo's values and principles.
- To take a creative and enthusiastic approach to making Mahdlo a valued facility in Oldham and a leader in its field.
- To promote a positive image of Mahdlo through professional operation and conduct with all our stakeholders and the general public.
