THE ROLE

Youth worker

Youth work supports a young person's personal, social and educational development.

We use youth work to explore their values and beliefs, to enable them to develop their voice and place in society, and to learn skills that help them to realise their full potential.

You will be delivering a range of exciting programmes to young people that will challenge, stimulate and provide new opportunities, in line with the Mahdlo themes of **Get Sorted** (personal development, crime prevention and health and wellbeing) and **Get Connected** (leadership, volunteering and citizenship).

You will be establishing positive relationships with young people; challenging, supporting and encouraging them as they develop.

WHAT YOU'LL BE DOING

Key responsibilities

- Working directly with children and young people (8-12 years and / or 13-19 years) to develop their social skills and build their confidence by delivering programmes of activities, services and facilities at Mahdlo which will take place during the evenings, at weekends and during school holidays and will occasionally include residential work.
- To directly deliver a planned, high quality programme of activity that is exciting, safe, and developmental and directly responds to the diverse needs, concerns and interests of our members. Offering opportunities and encouraging young people to participate in a range of activities and experiences across our 6 key themes: [Get Active](#); [Get Creative](#); [Get Sorted](#); [Get Outdoors](#); [Get Connected](#); [Get Ahead](#).
- Where required contribute to the development of plans for delivery of youth work sessions and projects.
- To deliver sessions which support with the delivery of preventative issue based youth work.
- To establish positive relationships with young people, to challenge, support and encourage them to participate positively.
- To work with children and young people in groups, 1-2-1 and in outreach settings.
- To work flexibly to ensure the needs of our members are met, including disadvantaged children and young people and those with disabilities or additional needs.
- To ensure that our members maintain a high standard of behaviour and discipline during sessions.
- To work alongside and support Activity Workers, Volunteers and Young Leaders to deliver our programmes.
- To promote cultural cohesion and inclusion, and proactively challenge any prejudice and discrimination.
- Ensure the participation of young people and that their ideas contribute fully in the delivery and evaluation of sessions, projects and activities.
- To understand and adhere to Mahdlo policies and procedures at all times with particular emphasis on equal opportunities, health and safety and safeguarding.

- To have responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people at all times.
- To monitor, record and evaluate sessions in accordance with Mahdlo's systems.
- To be an active member of the team and deliver a focused, measurable contribution to Mahdlo operating in line with Mahdlo's values and principles.
- To take a creative and enthusiastic approach to making Mahdlo a valued facility in Oldham and a leader in its field.
- To promote a positive image of Mahdlo through professional operation and conduct with all our stakeholders and the general public.

- Contribute positively to a range of exciting activity programmes for children and young people in the hub and districts that will challenge, stimulate and provide new opportunities, in line with the Mahdlo six key themes: **Get Active** (sports); **Get Creative** (arts); **Get Sorted** (personal development, crime prevention and health and wellbeing); **Get Outdoors** (outward bound and environmental activities); **Get Connected** (leadership, volunteering and citizenship); **Get Ahead** (employment and enterprise).
